

Continuing to improve our engagement with adults with lived experience utilising Active Outreach



Police Scotland Ayrshire Division have developed a 2-day learning session on ASP to provide a cache of officers who are ASP Champions



Developing tools to support multi-agency engagement at ASP Case Conferences.

What we are doing THIS YEAR



Engage our Council Officers in Safe & Together learning sessions to improve their understanding of domestic violence and the whole family approach.

Undertaking an annual multiagency self-evaluation of Adult Support and Protection in respect of adult at risk of harm who have a learning disability.
