TOPIC: **Care & Risk Management (CARM): Managing Children & Young People Who Present a Risk of Serious Harm**

and

Multi-agency Risk Management Framework and Protocol for Children with Sexually Harmful Behaviours

BRIEFING: The above mentioned documents – which can be accessed via the hyperlinks below – provide multi-agency staff with information on the revised processes used to ensure that those children and young people in East Ayrshire who present a risk of serious harm to themselves or others, as a result of their potential for damaging sexual, violent or self-harming behaviour, are managed effectively to minimise those risks.

Practitioners should be aware that the information provided in the above documents is part of the Whole Systems Approach and should be considered alongside the Nation Guidance – Framework for Risk Assessment Management and Evaluation (FRAME). The CARM guidance and protocol was agreed by the East Ayrshire Child Protection Committee (EACPC) on 3 March 2015 and the Multi-agency Risk Management Framework and Protocol for Children with Sexually Harmful Behaviours was agreed by the EACPC for adoption in East Ayrshire on 7 June 2016, and they are now being implemented across all agencies.
