## Police Report

Written report sent to Secretary there are no serious cases to bring to the Councils attention all current incidents are under investigation .

## Causes for Concern

Pigeon Club building has been broken into and the Children are in the Building, what is the Police doing about this.

**Ans.** We will speak to the Parents and the children if there is any damage then charges will be handed down. We will patrol the area in question It is the responsibility of the owners to insure the Security and Safety of the Building.

Speeding through the Village is a serious cause for concern with kids coming and going from School.

**Ans** We monitor this on a regular basis it seems mostly to be at the change of shift between 8am and 9am

Unlicenced Motor Cycles and Quads are tearing up the open spaces In the Village and causing a noise nuisance.

**Ans.** We will investigate this

The house at the top of Lime Road has been broken into, Children are inside

**Ans** This is an ongoing situation we have spoken to the Parents we will continue to monitor the house.

## Reports

Scotland Transerve is still adamant that the £2000 cheque from the Minerals Trust for the Christmas Lights has not been received. The information from the Minerals Trust is that the cheque was cashed on 19th January. Transerve will be contacted again to resolve the matter.

A request to East Ayrshire Council for the summer seat to commemorate the 100 years anniversary of the ending of WW1 should in the interim be situated at a site at Pathhead until such times as the proper site is ready. Council has been contacted.

The Bridge at the Station Brae is dangerous and the road subsiding and the wall in a very poor condition. The Council are saying it is safe, what can be done about it  
A planned drawing was produced to the Community Council showing work to be to be carried out on bridge.

The road condition on the Lime Road is deteriorating badly with a drain cover sinking and large holes appearing making it difficult for cars and vans to miss  
Council reports it in their to do list and will be carried out.

Knockshinnoch Memorial site has been subject to vandalism again with scoring on the plaque and broken bottles and rubbish strewn about it needs cleaning before  
It gets into a dumping ground.

## Discussions

The NewCumnock memorial to those local miners was discussed and the time it has taken to get this up and running. This was explained that Nerv had got prices and drew up a leaflet for the work only to be told that someone from the village had informed Historic Scotland Lottery that they would be taking over the project and therefore Nerv was taken out of the equation and could not get a application for the funding required.

It was agreed that Historic Scotland be informed that the Community Council is overseeing the project and the application form be applied for.

Eon requested a meeting with the Community Council in July, as the Community Council does not meet in July an open meeting in the Community Centre would need to suffice.

A request was made for an Benefits Officer to speak to the meeting as many people in the Village do not know what benefits they can claim and are struggling to get by on what little they are getting.  
It was agreed that it would be much better for an open meeting in the Centre to allow everyone to attend would be more beneficial.
