The plan is for **2024 to 2027**.



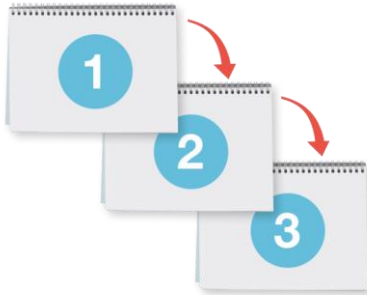
Important words in this document will be in **bold**.



What is a health and social care partnership strategic plan?



Health and social care partnerships were started so that local health and council services work better together.



A **strategic plan** is a document which says what is going to happen and how it is going to happen.



A law called the **Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Scotland) Act 2014** says that all health and social care partnerships must do a strategic plan **every three years**.



The plan says how services are going to work together in East Ayrshire.



Each health and social care partnership area must be split into smaller local areas. The plan says what will happen for each smaller local area in East Ayrshire.



The plan says how it will help with the health and wellbeing aims that the whole of Scotland is working towards. Health and wellbeing mean things like:

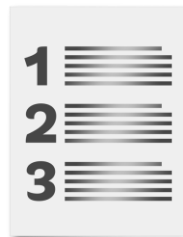
- our happiness

The **vision** of the plan is to “work together with our communities to improve and sustain health, wellbeing, care and promote equity.”



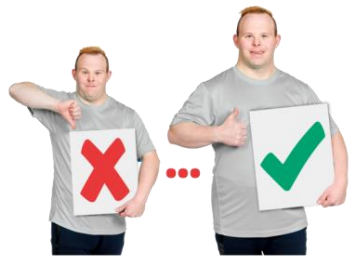
The plan has six **key areas of work**.

The fourth area of work is to make sure **staff are looked after**.



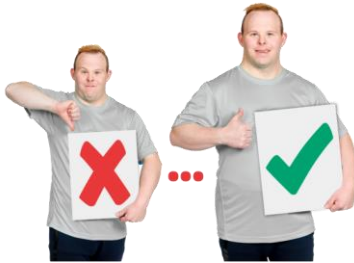
The fifth area of work is to make sure everyone is kept **safe**.
