We are pleased to announce that the Home Owners maintenance plan will continue for another year, we can also advise that the cost of the plan will remain at £12 per year (excluding VAT) Home Owners can enjoy the benefit of cover for emergency or urgent works to the door entry systems and common entry lighting (subject to certain criteria)
