UPDATE ON PROGRESS OF WORKS ON HURLFORD PRIMARY SCHOOL AND EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTRE

Firstly, I would like to thank you for your continuing support and cooperation which has meant that the transport of the children to Loudoun Academy has been working well. The children are now well used to the routine and enjoying being part of the 'big school' particularly the seniors who are in the secondary building well in advance of the primary 7s from the other schools who will join them as part of the new Loudoun Academy S1 group in August 2017.

I can also provide an update on progress with the work in Hurlford which I am sure you will have seen. The window installation is complete and the extension is now wind and watertight. New openings have been formed to the basement and steelwork is complete. The roof repairs are almost complete with pointing and stone repairs continuing. Ground works for the playground have begun and work to strengthen the lath and plaster ceilings has been completed with the additional internal improvements being progressed.

The Head Teacher has been involved in discussions with the architect to determine colours and finishes and new ICT provision is also being finalised.

Further updates will be provided prior to the summer in relation to progress and the arrangements for the school returning.
