UPDATE ON PROGRESS OF WORKS ON HURLFORD PRIMARY SCHOOL AND EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTRE

As the October school break approaches, I thought it would be useful to provide an update on recent developments.

Children in the Early Childhood Centre are well settled into their temporary accommodation and continue to enjoy their fantastic new surroundings.

Following a very short period of intense planning and organisation, the children are settled in their new temporary surroundings in Loudoun Academy. The children were very surprised to see that their classroom spaces looked almost identical to those in Hurlford and this is due, in no small measure, to the hard work and commitment of all involved.

After one or two minor adjustments to transport arrangements (and one or two initial tears), the children are now enjoying their adventure by bus every day to the 'big school'.

Works on site are progressing to plan. With the children being out of the building there has been an opportunity to accelerate some of the works, for example, window replacement and discussions are currently taking place on the scope of additional refurbishment works. I am pleased to report that a recent inspection of the roof shows that remedial work required is not as extensive as initially thought.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your patience, support and cooperation. I will continue to keep you informed of developments in relation to the upgrading works.
