

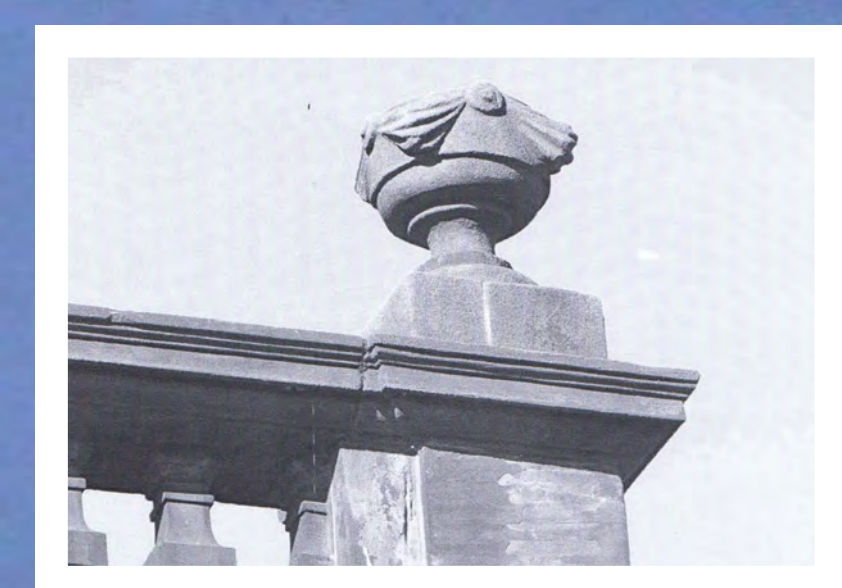


KILMARNOCK TOWNSCAPE HERITAGE INITIATIVE

Area to promote, preserve and enhance the traditional character and appearance of properties in the area. The



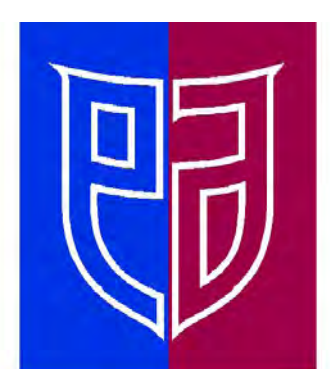

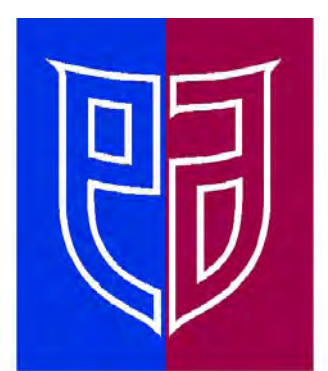
Kilmarnock THI Grants are available to owners of commercial and residential premises within the boundary of the John Finnie Street/ Bank Street Outstanding Conservation Area. There are different types of grant assistance available under the scheme. Projects can attract 80% grant funding towards eligible costs. The grant scheme can offer grants covering comprehensive building repair schemes and smaller scale works such as window replacement or masonry repairs. The scheme is now in its final phase; therefore, there is limited availability for grant assistance, please contact the Kilmarnock THI office if you wish to enquire about grant availability.
