# What is the Main Issues Report?




The Planning Authority are in the early stages of the preparation of Local Development Plan 2 which will replace the current East Ayrshire Local Development Plan (EALDP) which was adopted in 2017.

The first stage in this process is the development of the Main Issues Report (MIR).

The Main Issues Report identifies **key changes affecting East Ayrshire**, and the associated development and land use issues that must be addressed within LDP2.

The Main Issues Report sets out our **preferred** and **alternative options** (approaches) for tackling these issues.

The Main Issues Report sets out how we would like East Ayrshire to look in 20 years' time.









The Main Issues Report outlines 29 issues which are considered to be vital topics to be addressed within the next Local Development Plan.

The Main Issues report is split into 9 sections:

- 1. Vision and Aims
- 2. Spatial Strategy
- 3. Approach to Placemaking
- 4. Enabling Housing
- 5. Successful Town Centres
- 6. Infrastructure

- 7. Historic Environment
- 8. Planning for Climate Change: Renewable energy, flooding, minerals and low carbon places
- 9. Priorities, Issues and Proposals

The Main Issues Report does not cover all topics that will eventually be contained within the Proposed Plan, but simply focuses on the topics that we think are most significant.









After the consultation period has closed, all representations received will be examined and used to inform the **Proposed Plan** which is due for publication in **Autumn 2021**.




#### The Impact of COVID-19 on public engagement:


