

Alcohol Brief Interventions (ABI) – Quarter 3 – 2017/18

Ayrshire & Arran have been set a yearly target of delivering 4,275 ABIs.

- 80% (3,419) is to be delivered within Priority Settings whilst 20% (856) is to be delivered within Non Priority Wider Settings

There are Quarterly Targets for 2017/18 of 20% delivery, then 25%, then 25% and 30% in the final quarter (this incremental approach is due to delays in funding agreements and consequently delays in implementing ABI delivery within the Primary Care setting).

As a consequence of the South Ayrshire ADP reducing their funding allocation to GP Primary Care ABI delivery by 24% from the previous year (£6,607 to £5,000 for 2017/18), the South Ayrshire ADP have the responsibility for ensuring that the Primary Care setting within South Ayrshire delivers a minimum of 345 ABIs over the year.
