

LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 CONFIRMATION OF SITE NOTICE

(include postcode)	
Name & Address of premises (include postcode)	
A notice regarding an application for a premises licence or for variation of such a licence is required to be displayed for a period of not less than 21 days. If the Licensing Board is not satisfied that this has taken place, it may order the display of the notice for a further 21 days. Should the notice without any fault or intention of the applicant be removed, obscured or defaced before the end of the 21 days for which it must be displayed, the applicant must take reasonable steps for its protection and if need be its replacement. If this has happened, the applicant must note it and set out what he or she has done to correct the situation (in the box below).
