A cohort of young people from Robert Burns Academy will be involved in the following projects, organised by Archaeology Scotland:

- Archaeological Dig
- Graveyard Survey
- Historic Building Recording



Archaeological Excavation



Open for all participants will learn the skills and processes in conducting a dig, including an introduction to tools, marking out trenches, de-turfing, excavation techniques, recording, photography and surveying.

No previous experience is needed. All tools, guidance and supervision will be provided by Archaeology Scotland.

Graveyard Survey



Our group of young people will discover how archaeologists record historic graveyards, including; checking headstone inscriptions, understanding carved symbols and assessing condition and capturing this information on memorial recording forms

Areas of the cemetery will be chosen to demonstrate how the layout of a graveyard can be recorded. It will also include hands-on surveying of parts of the site using a manual plane table and electronic equipment, followed by a comparison of the results with an existing sketch of the churchyard. The young people will also learn how to create 3D scans of selected headstones.

Historic Building Recording



A hands-on workshop to experience the techniques. The group will learn what details should be included within a record, this session will encourage our cohort from Robert Burns Academy to discover how archaeologists record historic buildings, teaching the techniques of high-level Historic Building Recording.
