Additional funding secured

In collaboration with Mauchline Community Council we recently submitted a bid for additional funding from the Renewable Energy Fund (REF). The funds are planned to be utilised to support the manufacture and install of some additional street furniture around the village.

We are very happy to share with you that we have been successful in our application allowing us to progress with this project. The works planned include;

- •New benches at the side of the Fairburn Hotel, with the current bench being relocated to the rear of the carpark,
- •New bench at Poosie Nansies and The Cross.
- •New planters at The Cross and the rear of Loudoun Street Carpark

We would like to take this opportunity to thank all parties involved and also to thank the Renewable Energy Fund in their support of our project.
