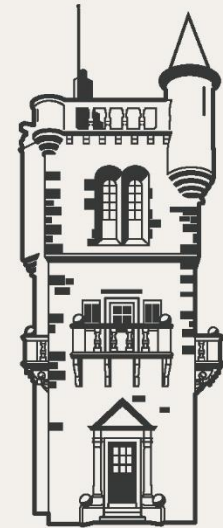

# Street Lighting Improvements

## *Historic Lighting Styles- Wall Mounted Lights*

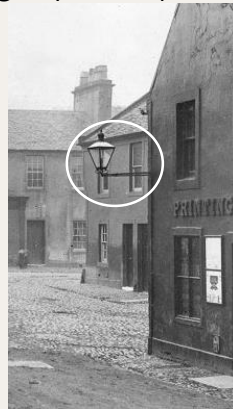
Shown opposite are the typical styles of wall lighting used throughout the village. The example here is shown on the corner of the Burns House Museum.

Wall mounted street lighting was the primary source of street lighting within the village according to historic pictures. Historic pictures show various examples of this lighting across properties along Loudoun Street, The Cross and Earl Grey Street.

Interestingly a wall light bracket which was originally located at 23 Loudoun street now adorns the private residence of 'Springfield', Mansefield road. Although slightly adapted from its original style.

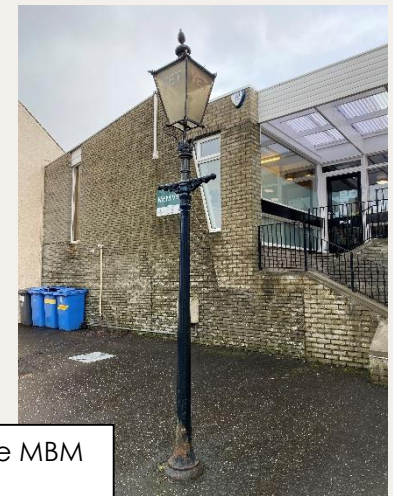

In accordance with historic pictures of the village there was only two locations which hosted a post style light. These were of two different designs as noted opposite.

The first was located at the old toll gates on Kilmarnock road, traditional lights similar in style can still be found in the village. One being located at Hayhill Developments office as you enter the village and the other outside the MBM Vets both on Kilmarnock Road.

The second post style lighting was located on Loudoun Street at the northern corner of the now Co-op. The styles found in historic pictures will be used when considering replacement lighting.



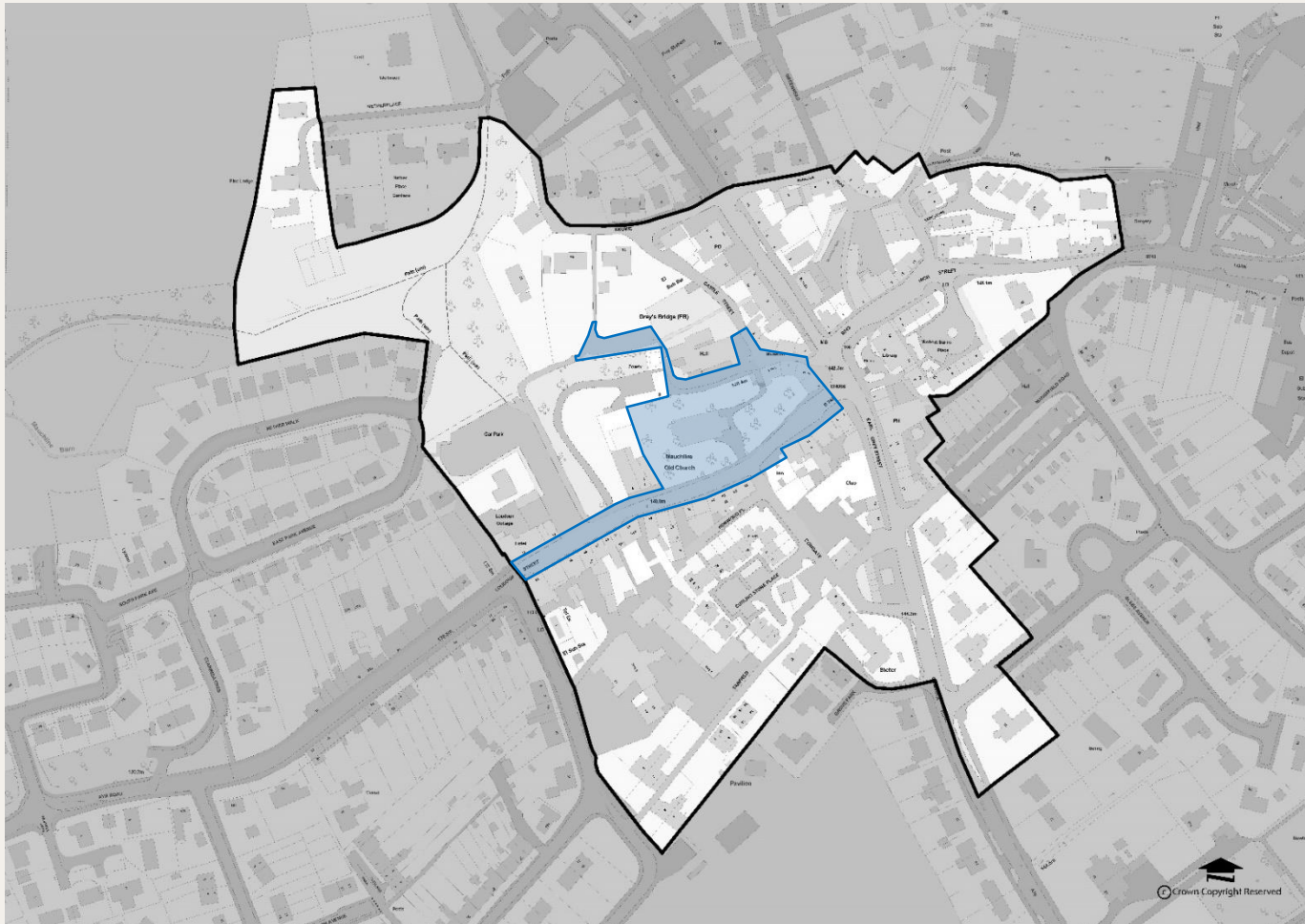

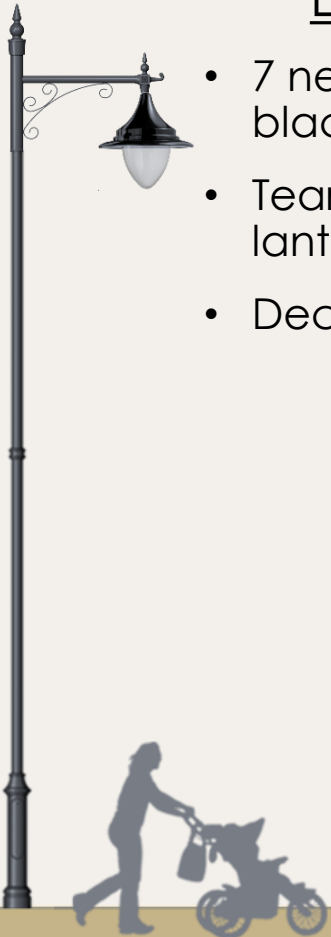
# Street Lighting Improvements

- 7 new columns, painted black
- Teardrop heritage style lantern.
- Decorative base



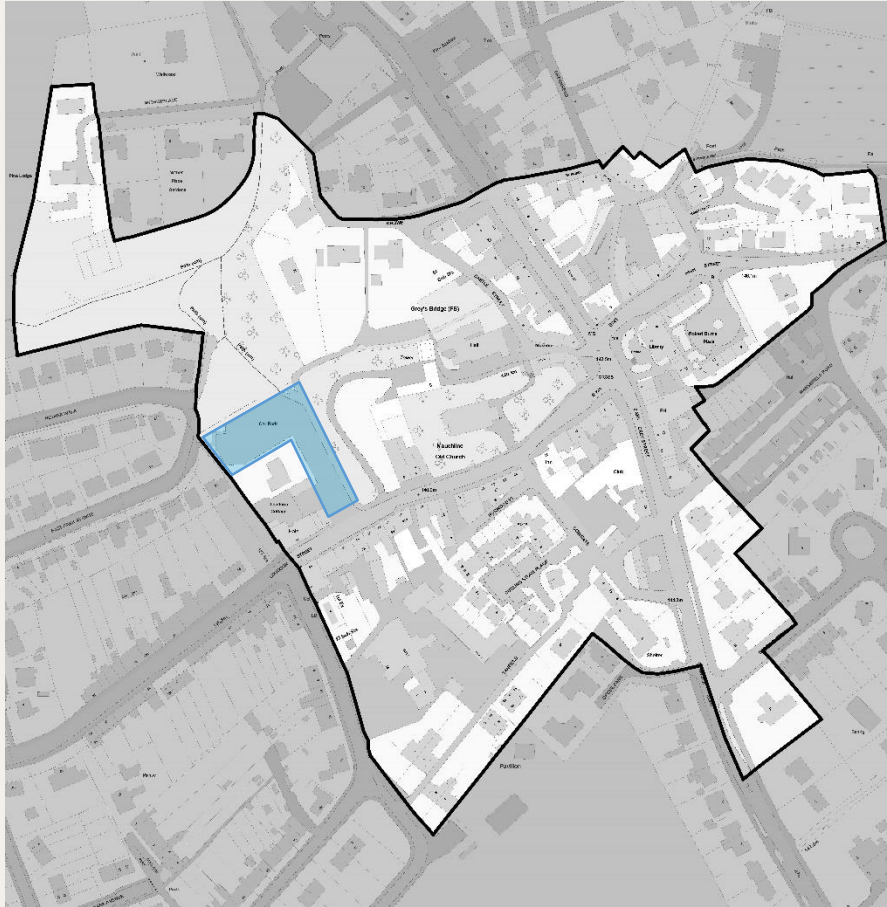
### Churchyard & Lanes

- Repair to two damaged light posts and install new lanterns.
- Replacement of 22 lanterns to a traditional style.
- All posts cleaned and painted all posts black.



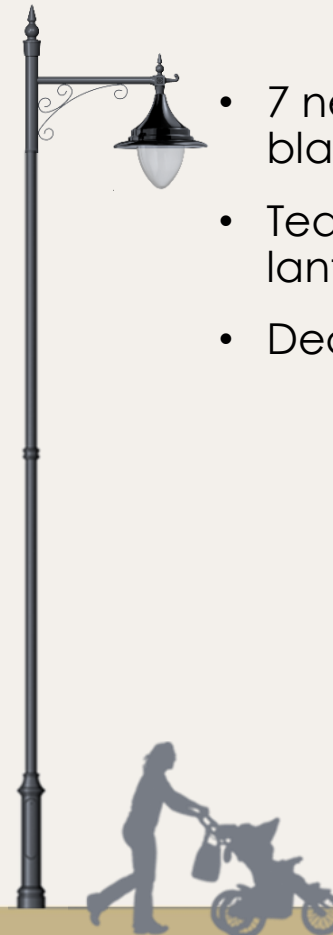

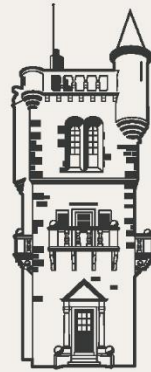
## Phase 2 Allocation Map & Style
