Regulations 2022. There are 4 levels of remuneration payments dependent on responsibilities of Councillors. TRAVEL & SUBSISTENCE - These allowances are claimable by Councillors in respect of expenses incurred in undertaking approved duties. The approved duties relate to attendance at local and national level as well as relating to  $\label{lem:councillor's constituency work. The allowances are set by Regulation.$ 

Such costs are met direct by the Council but require to be published as a cost to the Councillor. PROVOST ALLOWANCE - This allowance is paid to offset expenditure incurred by the Provost or Depute Provost carrying out their Civic duties. The maximum yearly allowance prescribed by Regulation for East Ayrshire Council is £3,000.  $also\ provided\ to\ the\ Provost\ and\ Depute\ Provost\ in\ respect\ of\ their\ Civic\ Ceremonial\ Duties\ on\ behalf\ of\ the\ Council.$ The cost of transportation includes associated employee costs.
