37th Ayrshire Scouts - Go Wild	We plan to offer every child who is a member of the 37 th Scouts an opportunity to camp in the wild during the next year. To do this we need to invest in light weight camping gear that the Young People can carry into remote locations. We also need some personal kit to support some of our members who are unable to buy such items.	£2268
Park School - Cafes 56: Helping the Homeless	Our plan is to provide a hot meal to homeless people in our community wing at least once before the summer holidays, then at least once a term next session. As pupils at Park School we are used to being supported, we would like to use our skills for work to support others.	£650
Connecting Voices We Care About Homeless People	The group plan to hire one of the local community centres and their cooking equipment for one day. Two to three young people aged 18 – 23 will be responsible for cooking and preparing the food. *All young people involved in cooking have hygiene certificates. One young person is involved in marketing the event, designing posters etc. The plan is to cook the food in the afternoon and then serve in the evening to an estimated 100 homeless and vulnerable people. The group would also like to make sandwiches for people to take home with them to cover one other meal for that day.	£550
Scottish Fire & Rescue Fire Fighter Cadets- 2018 Projects with the Community	The money will be used to allow the young people in Kilmarnock to develop their social, communicative and interpersonal skills in the community by working in partnership with members of the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service. It also allows the young people new opportunities by progressing in a simulated workplace. The money will help support the unit in providing these opportunities to the young people of Kilmarnock and allows additional trips to become possible.	£2,000
Barnardo's Youth Service EA Families	This would allow us to purchase new and up to date resources that would attract a greater number of young people. Also support holiday provision that will pay for external practitioners.	£2,000
4ward2gether - Diversity for Young People	We have run the Celebrating Diversity weekend for years, but now we want to have an event to bring young people together with music. There will be stalls and entertainment run by and for young people during the day and a concert at night.	£2,400
Kilmarnock YMCA - New Adventures	The funding will be used to finance an annual programme of activities that will involve volunteers and young people sports including ball sports, dry slope skiing, swimming, table tennis and ice skating and an adventure outdoor residential weekend including arts and crafts activities, chess, table tennis, cooking and sewing tuition. The programme changes as new members arrive and identify activities via a questionnaire, so the above is not an exhaustive list.	£2,000
Bonnyton Community Centre - Community Centre Upgrade	To upgrade our chairs in the Centre and make it more warm and welcoming. A more modern look to encourage more people and groups to use it.	£3,000

Active Graduates - Active Summer Camp	The Active Graduates is run by young volunteers to promote and encourage children and families to lead a healthy and active lifestyle through the promotion of practical, fun learning programmes; encouraging participation of children and families to make sustained improvements in their diet, physical activity levels and overall health. The Active Graduates are looking for funds to deliver a health summer 2018 boot camp for families and children aged 5 – 12 years across the Kilmarnock locality.	£1,000
Centrestage - White Cube Gallery	We propose a Pop Up “White Cube” Gallery. This will be led and delivered by the young people of our Leadership Connect Project Leadership Connect young people come from across Kilmarnock and beyond and attend Connect by way of helping them to re-engage with learning and their school curriculum. We propose for young people to take the lead and curate the gallery space entirely.	£1,790
Kilmarnock Youth Forum - Kilmarnock Community Fun Day	To run a community fund day to bring the young people of Kilmarnock together. We want to show off the people’s talents and also provide fun sports and activities for the community.	£342
