<b>Beautiful Inside and Out</b>	<b>Room to Breathe</b> To support troubled souls and bereaved families of suicide in Kilmarnock, through counselling, play therapy, music therapy with qualified therapists. Funding will go towards providing a safe space and promote self-worth.	<b>£1000</b>
<b>Patchwork</b>	<b>All Day Patchwork</b> To support the group to open the Leishman Hall from 2pm – 8pm fortnightly on a Friday to offer craft classes, involving simple woodwork and support the group to become more involved.	<b>£1000</b>
<b>East Ayrshire Churches Homelessness Action</b>	<b>Community Friends</b> Community Friends run drop-ins three days per week for homeless and vulnerable people. To support their programme, they are looking to organise at least two outings over the summer which would normally be outwith the reach of those they support.	<b>£400</b>
<b>Ayrshire Samaritans</b>	<b>Talk To Us 24/7</b> To support Ayrshire Samaritans deliver a one day event (24/7) to promote their service and draw attention the number of suicides in Ayrshire. It would also act as a precursor for the Kilmarnock Festival.	<b>£1000</b>
