NOTES ON COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM

1. "Petroleum Spirit" is defined as such petroleum as when tested by the appropriate method

gives off an inflammable vapour at a temperature of less than 73°F

(22.7°C).

"Petroleum" includes crude petroleum, oil made from petroleum or from coal, shale,

peat or other bituminous substances, and other products of petroleum.

2. Examples of substances covered by above definitions: Toluene, Xylene, Benzene, n-Hexane, cyclo-Hexane, Cellulose Lacquer solutions, cellulose thinners, Adhesive Solution, Liquid Polishes. If in doubt whether a product requires a storage licence, consult a Petroleum Officer at the office indicated on the front page.

3. If applicant is a sole trader, then please give full name.

If applicant is a Company set up under the Companies Act, then please give full Company name together with name of the Company Secretary.

A partnership should list the name of each partner.

- 4. If you do not have a registered address, then give your main place of business in Great Britain.
- 5. Please state the maximum quantity of Petroleum Spirit/Petroleum Mixtures capable of being stored at anytime. In the case of Petroleum Spirit (petrol), this quantity must include the contents of motor vehicles.
- 6. State accurately the method of storage and the location of the installation, storehouse, container, etc.
- 7. Please state the name and designation of the person who is responsible for the operations carried out at the licensed premises.
- 8. This application must be signed by, in the case of,
 - (a) a sole trader the applicant
 - (b) a partnership one of the partners
 - (c) a company a director or company secretary.
