We anticipate demand for this room increasing following this extensive refurbishment



Once the start date for the works was confirmed as Thursday 11th January 2024 I started taking photographs for our records.

We do this for all our refurbishment projects and it is normally a condition for the funders.

While we had the builders here we decided to refurbish the side entrance hall, the cost of which will be met from the Association Funds.



The following slides are going to show the before and during pictures of the room. You might think the room wasn't too bad however if you look closely you start to realise how tired it was and also things like the industrial looking trunking etc.

The ceiling was in a particularly poor condition, this will be replaced by an insulated acoustic ceiling. The lighting was poor and expensive to run with 24 individual fluorescent light tubes contained within 6 light fittings. This will be replaced by LED panel lighting.

The heating system was 4 large cast iron radiators and this will be replaced with 2 easily regulated modern radiators.

All of these improvements will ensure that we are lowering our carbon footprint.
























This has really been a boost for the Association to receive the Place Base Funding and has greatly helped our Refurbishment programme.
