



### The Community Fund and the Training & Education Fund are administered by Dalmellington Parish Trust.

- Community Fund ~ £50,000 per annum (Two categories of grant Small Grant up to £1,000 and Medium Grant £1,000 - £3,000)
- Training & Education Fund ~ £15,000 per annum

# Community Fund

# This is a rolling annual fund of £50,000 that will be administered 4 times per year with £12,500 paid out each quarter as follows:

#### Period 1

November – Applications open 1<sup>st</sup> November December – closing date 15<sup>th</sup> December January – by end of January, applications will be processed and paid out

#### Period 3

May – Applications open 1<sup>st</sup> May June – closing date 15<sup>th</sup> June July – by end of July, applications will be processed and paid out

#### Period 2

February – Applications open 1<sup>st</sup> February March - closing date 15<sup>th</sup> March April – by end of April, applications will be processed and paid out

#### Period 4

August – Applications open 1<sup>st</sup> August September – closing date 15<sup>th</sup> September October – by end of October, applications will be processed and paid out

## Eligibility criteria:

- 1. Applications are invited from groups, individuals, businesses or organisations who are living, based or operating within Dalmellington Parish which covers Bellsbank, Burnton, Dalmellington and Waterside.
- 2. Individuals and businesses who have an idea for a project can apply, but as above, the project must have a direct benefit to the residents of Dalmellington Parish.
- 3. Each group/organisation/individual/business can submit an application for more than one project.
- 4. There are two categories of grant: Small Grant of up to £1000 and Medium Grant £1000 £3000.
- 5. The project will be fully open, transparent and comply with Equalities Legislation.
- 6. Once allocated the funding mut be used for the specified project and cannot be transferred to a third party.

Your project must help to deliver at least one of the following priorities:

- Physical improvements
- Tourism and heritage
- Environmental/Sustainable development
- Community pride and events
- Community facilities
- Community Health and Wellbeing

**Recognition of Grant Support:** Applicants will be required to give appropriate recognition to the fund by press/media/social media releases.
