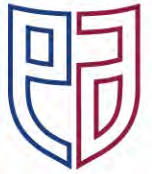

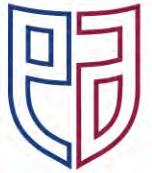

- All projects must be for works based within communities of East Ayrshire
 - Capital Funded Project
- Community Groups, Public Sector Organisations including Charities, Housing Associations, HSCP and Council services as well as private sector organisations can apply
- Fund: No min or max spend stated but “Share the Love”

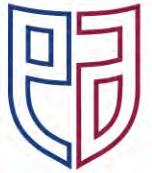

 - Cabinet - **May 2024**
- Notifications to successful candidates – **May 2024**
 - Contracts in place by - **31 December 2024**
 - Work completed by – **31 December 2025**
