

- Trips and visits








Special Youth Work Projects It's a Small World

Social Prescribing

• Social Prescribing

- G.P.'s and other NHS professionals; DWP; SDS & Education department refer individuals with low level mental health issues; obesity; diabetes etc., to reduce their dependency on health service and help them to engage with their community as a means of building confidence and self-belief
- Low level mental health issues including stress; depression; loneliness; anxiety etc
- Referrals from General Practitioner or NHS professional (e.g., mental health nursing staff etc.) only
- 3 months support



The Living Room

- The Living Room simple but has a lot of meaning used for mindfulness
- Emphasis on the word Living
 - Feeling safe, loved, included and protected. Being confident to deal with life and resilient enough to deal with adversity
- "a room in a house for general everyday use with a comfortable living room with sofas, chairs, TV and a dining table"





Our Future Now - Inspiring Scotland

- Original investment (originally from 14:19 Fund)
- Aged 14 to 25 years not in education, employment or training
- Programme to suit the needs of the young person
- One to one support/mentoring and provision of 'hands on' learning opportunities
- Focus on Positive Destinations
 - Mainstream education
 - Volunteering
 - Further Education
 - Employment

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
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Background to the Skills Shop

- Truancy or unexplained absence in East Ayrshire Schools
- Inspiring Scotland investment cohort reduced to age 14 years (S3 pupils) as a means of earlier intervention of age 16 years


Pupils with truancy or unexplained absence three year period 2019/2020; 2020/2021; 2021;2022

- Programme delayed until mid October 2023 due to logistics and administration challenges



Challenges


- Communication
 - Guidance staff
 - Referrals names and parental consent forms
 - Parents
 - To give assurance their child would be safer in yipworld than not
 - Young People
 - Anxiety and fear of crowds
 - Lack of confidence
 - Little or no aspirations
 - Unwillingness to learn

- 21 referrals received
- Open day for further information
- Door to door consultation with parents/carers
- Completed the parental consent form to reduce impact on time
- 13 attended and continue to attend on a weekly basis




Skills Shop Male/Female/Other




Skills Shop by Secondary Year

Place based investment fund

- Grant application submitted
- Reviewed and approved by Cabinet
- Total application £13,500>
 - Capital cost £6,700
- In-kind provision of staff time and resource matched with Inspiring Scotland Our Future Now Fund
- Pilot project
 - Mid-term review March 2024
