

Knockroon Learning Campus
New Cumnock Consultation Meeting
Monday 9 March 2015

In attendance: Graham Short (Executive Director Educational & Social Services), John Wilson (Senior Education Manager), New Cumnock PS Principal Teacher and 5 attendees.

Following the presentation, the following Issues were raised:

- **How will NCPS pupils benefit from the resources and experiences at the new campus?**
 - A sustainable and meaningful programme will be developed to ensure that there is a positive impact for pupils attending all associated primary schools
- **Concern raised re walking routes and access for transport at peak times.**
 - The assessment of safe walking routes is a high priority and will reflect nationally agreed criteria and be carried out by professionals from the Roads Dept. Where necessary, free/concessionary transport will be provided.
- **If the 'two primary' option was chosen, where would the location be?**
 - The location would be at Broomfield and would include Hillside.
- **Concern raised re the future of Riverside Centre.**
 - Riverside Centre will not be affected by the proposal
- **Could a new secondary be built on the Broomfield site and the new primary school be built on the current CA site?**
 - It would be financially beneficial to build one campus. There is also a significant number of educational benefits to having a multi-stage campus
- **Question raised re P7 swimming at Visions rather than NC.**
 - This would be investigated.
- **Concern re proximity of Scottish Water plant**
 - Measures would be taken to investigate fully and plan accordingly.
- **Concern re flooding**
 - Discussion took place re fluvial and pluvial flooding. Measures would be taken to investigate fully and plan accordingly.
