**Please Note:**

Any objection or representation relating to an application shall be entertained by the Council  
only if the objection or representation:-

- (a) Is in writing (e-mails acceptable)
- (b) Specifies the grounds of the objection or representation
- (c) Specifies the name and address of the person making it
- (d) Is signed by the person or on his/her behalf
- (e) Is made within 28 days of the date the application was submitted to the Council  
(see above for date).

## **GUIDANCE NOTES**

1. On the date you submit your application, please complete the “Notice for Display at Premises” and display it at or near the premises for a period of 21 consecutive days.
2. If you are unable, for any reason, to display the Notice for a period of 21 days, a declaration to this effect must be made on the Certificate of Compliance.
3. Certificate of Compliance - After 21 days, complete the Certificate of Compliance and return it to the address given on the form. The Certificate of Compliance can be obtained via
