# Introduction

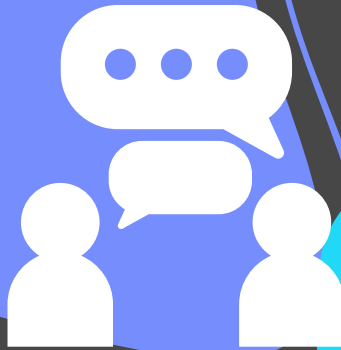

## What has changed?

- EAC Environmental Health campaign on litter
- Regular community litter picks
- 10 additional litter bins

## Priority 2

Better play parks and  
improved countryside  
environment

- Upgrade to Lainshaw Play park
- Cunninghame Watt Park maintained
- Stewarton Woodlands Action Trust maintain Lainshaw Woods paths

## Priority 3

Upgrade The Cross and  
Stewarton Town Centre

- Annual flower baskets in town centre
- 9 shopfronts improved through £22,000 of funding from Place Based Investment Programme, Scotland's Towns Partnership and East Ayrshire Council administered by Stewarton Initiatives.

- Greater police presence in the area, however it is not possible to reopen the police station
- Police Scotland hold a monthly open session to engage with local community members
- Progress has been made to build the Community Hub which will help target this area of work
- Some residents groups have been established across the town in different streets / estate areas

- This continues to be an issue across the town and is framing discussion as part of Local Development Plan review
- Robertland Square accessible housing development
- David Dale Avenue renovation
- External rendering completed across various areas

- New footpath at Cutstraw Road

- Annick Active Travel project in progress

Improve traffic management, calming and surfaces

- Raising awareness of traffic issues at the schools
- Traffic calming at Lainshaw Primary , Old Kilmarnock Road and Vennel/Holm Street and Loudon Street instigated
