East Ayrshire Council established in terms of the Local Government etc (Scotland) Act 1994, in exercise of the powers conferred to them by Section 208 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 as amended, and all other powers enabling them on that behalf, being satisfied that it is necessary to authorise the temporary stopping up and diversion of the footpath hereinafter specified in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Act, and having complied with the provisions of Schedule 208 and Schedule 16 of the Act hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the temporary Stopping Up and Diversion of Footpath (Green Street, Kilmarnock) Order 2024 and shall come into operation on 10 March 2025.
- 2. In this Order:

"footpath" means the length of footpath in East Ayrshire that is specified in the Schedule of this Order.

- 3. The temporary stopping up and diversion of the footpath is hereby authorised.
- 4. Where, immediately before the date of this Order, there are any rights of statutory undertakers in respect of any apparatus of theirs which is under, in, on, over, along or across the road, such undertakers shall thereafter, without prejudice to the provision of Sections 224 and 225 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 have the same rights in respect of that apparatus as they had immediately before that date.
