GROUND BREAKING CEREMONY

Councillor Reid, Leader of the Council, Provost Jim Todd, Cllrs Tom Cook, Maureen McKay and Hugh Ross were all onsite for the ceremony. Councillor Reid said: **“Whatriggs Primary and Early Childhood Centre will provide our children and young people with a state of the art learning environment and our community with purpose built meeting facilities.”**

The children are also being involved in all the important decisions, like choosing a new uniform. A competition, which was won by Holli Marshall from Bellfield Primary, allowed the children to create their own uniform and new motto – Smart Mind – Kind Heart. The new uniform is currently being designed and will be unveiled in the near future.

Morrison Construction has been working with the children from both schools delivering site safety training ensuring that they are aware of the dangers a building site can bring. They have also been working with the Council’s Employability Service to ensure that local people have an opportunity to work at the site.
