Information Session for parents and carers held in June 2018

- Q. Would prefer that mainstream classes were together to allow for collaborative work to continue.
- A. This was a decision made by senior managers within the school and reflects good practice already established in the school and across the Authority. To promote inclusion, Communication Centre classes are located beside the primary classes at the same stage. This will have no impact on collaborative work taking place between mainstream classes.

Q. CCC Playground - Is this for all infants now? Is it changing - safer ground to play on - access directly to/from school?

A. The CC playground will remain for mainly Communication Centre Pupils who find the larger playground overwhelming. It can be accessed by other infant classes with their teacher. It is envisaged that the outdoor spaces will all be addressed as part of the refurbishment and that all children will have a quality playground.

Q. The plans show only 1 designated cleaners store. At present the school has 3 cleaners stores with access to water and with the one store on the plans and another store designated for cleaners purpose would give staff after the extension is complete adequate storage for existing equipment, any new equipment required, consumables, coat hooks and IT access. 2 stores spring to mind. 1 behind the computer server cupboard (15m<sup>2</sup>) with water access at the wash trough area for mop buckets (7m<sup>2</sup>) or 1 next to the current library with large sink (12m<sup>2</sup>)

A. Design drawings now revised to indicate 4 Cleaner's Store Cupboards, all with sinks and storage space. 2 stores per floor.

Q. Plans look good. I don't see any provision for a computer room or would this be within the library?

A. Enhanced mobile technology will be provided which offers greater flexibility for digital learning to take place across the whole school.

A. The pitch will be of a sufficient size to allow for a wide variety of activities and sports. It is anticipated that flooring for the GP room to allow PE activities to take place will be provided.
